## Equipment and Packing List for the OB International World Conference

## General

As you will all know from the website, this world conference will be slightly different from others in the past, due to the remote location, limited connectivity, and the simplicity of the accommodation for the desert element.

Oman, like many countries, has a big issue with plastics. In an attempt to minimize that, you will see in the list below that we ask you to bring your own water bottle, and coffee mug. With over 120 people being at the conference, we suggest you make yours distinctive!

Personal Medication	Please remember to bring any that you may
